We are here in Stuart, Florida, at the wonderful Hutchinson Island Marriott Beach Resort and Marina to celebrate our *Twenty-Fifth Annual Passover and Feast of Unleavened Bread* 2005/6008. I am thoroughly pleased, gratified, and elated to see all of you who are in attendance today to be in accord, harmony, and conformity with the holy and righteous laws of our Father, הוה בן יהוה בן יהוה לוה בן יהוה בן יהוה לוה שלים. The law of the Passover/Feast of Unleavened Bread is mandated to be kept and observed by all Hebrew Israelites in our history book, the King James Version of the Holy Bible.

So, welcome, family and friends to our seminar discussion this morning of, "The Seven Last Plagues," Part 2. Praise יהוה! Our examination, perusal, and breakdown of our seminar today will be accomplished and perfected through the practice and application of the Divine Ten-Step Study Method of יהוה בן יהוה של '. We will seek to be diligent and zealous in our passage of enlightenment to maintain and live up to the Scripture, 2 Timothy, Chapter 2, verse 15, to study and show ourselves approved unto our God, יהוה להוה מוליי. Praise בן יהוה Praise יהוה יהוה אונים.

In our previous discussion, "The Seven Last Plagues," Part 1, we laid the foundation for this seminar series by decoding and deciphering the phrase, "And I saw another sign in heaven," from our foundation Scripture, Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1. At this point, we will perform a recap and review what we mentioned and stated in that seminar before moving on to our next segment.

In part one of "The Seven Last Plagues," we told you that Verse 1 of Revelation, Chapter 15 is the basis for the remainder of the Chapter, which describes the preparation of the pouring out of the seven last vials (bowls) of plagues which will constitute the final expression of the wrath of מווח during the Great Tribulation.

We learned that the word *and* was used at the beginning of our foundation Scripture to show that some particular occurrences would take place in Revelation, Chapter 15 that would be in addition to and connected with specific occurrences that took place in Revelation, Chapter 14. Secondly, we validated that the person speaking and writing in Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1, was none other than the Prophet John, who was characterized by the word *I*.

It was documented through our research of the word *saw* that John was able to apply his mental faculty in comprehending the importance of what was revealed unto him by an angel of a through the use of a written or other visual source. Furthermore, we defined the word *another* to realize that the Prophet John beheld a sign in Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1 that was different from the one he first considered in Chapter 14.

This *sign* that John viewed was a portentous incident that was unspecifiably significant which, as a result, elicited exciting wonder and awe from him. The incident or event that was manifested unto John was prophetically symbolic and served as an indication, warning, omen, and phenomenon of future good or evil.

Lastly, we verified that the holy Prophet John became aware of these events that were signified unto him by an angel of הוה while he was in heaven, meaning within the utmost limits, bounds, and area of elevation in his character and spirit or the height of his nobility. John also witnessed these incidents and events when he was at the topmost limit, or at the best and the most one could be to achieve.

Therefore, John was suitably enlightened about the appointed length of time before the future event--the pouring out of the last vials of the wrath of יהוה expected to take place, which was during the time he was aloft in a mental and spiritual high place. Praise

Presently, we are ready to begin our study process of the next portion of our foundation Scripture, Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1. But, first, the Scripture will be read with the elements we have already decoded from our last seminar. Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1, please read:

"[In addition to the occurrences in Revelation, Chapter 14, I, John, a servant of ההוה, came to find out information that was not previously known before because it was being hidden. But an angel of ההוה has told me, in a written source, about a second portentous incident or phenomenon that is evidence of future evil. This occurred while I was at the height of achievement. What I saw was an exciting wonder,] great and marvelous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God, הזוה."

Praise יהוה!

Now, let us proceed in our unveiling and discovery of the truth of Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1, by deciphering the next phrase in sequence, "great and marvelous." On the authority of The New Strong's Expanded Exhaustive Concordance of the Bible, Red-Letter Edition, copyright 2001, on page 52 of the Hebrew dictionary, under the references 1419 and 1431, great is spelled from right to left אדל סד אדל (Gimmel, Dalet, Wav, Lamed or Gimmel, Dalet, Lamed), pronounced gahdol or gahdahl. Gahdol, which derives from gahdahl, means "loud and mighty."

For us to gain a better understanding of how *great* this sign was that John saw, we will define the words **loud** and **mighty**. **Loud** is stated in the *Cambridge Dictionary of American English*, copyright 2000, Computer Software, as "producing a large amount of sound." It also states that, "If something is **loud and clear**, it is easily understood." **Sound** is also equivalent to "vocal utterances." This being the case, we can deduce that the sign John viewed, represented as being *great*, produced a large amount of vocal utterances that John was able to hear **loud and clear**; therefore, they were easily understood by him.

loud, is also defined in *Merriam Webster's 11th Collegiate Dictionary*, copyright 2003, Computer Software, as "free from error and fallacy; logically valid and having true premises." **Premises** are facts and data. Based upon these definitions, we can conclude that the vocal utterances or words emanating from this sign are free from error and fallacy. Furthermore, this **large amount of vocal utterances** that come from it are logically valid and have true facts and data which will be used to express the full spectrum of circumstances surrounding the Seven Last Plagues.

The word **mighty** also from the Hebrew word for *great* (*loud* and *mighty*) is validated in the *American Heritage Talking Dictionary*, copyright 1997, Computer Software, as "having power, strength, or force." So this *great* sign that John saw has utterances that have logically valid true facts and data which in turn, have power, strength, and force. Let us see what information the word **might**, the root word of **mighty**, can add to our explanation. **Might** is documented in the *Merriam Webster's* 11th Collegiate Dictionary, copyright 2003, Computer Software, as "the authority or resources wielded (as by a group)." To **wield** means to, "have at one's command or disposal." **Disposal** is equivalent to control, according to Roget's 21st Century Thesaurus, copyright 1992, 1993, 1999, on page 243.

At this interval, we can determine that this mighty sign which contains utterances that have logically valid true facts and data will also provide authority and resources to a particular group of individuals. These individuals who will have this authority at their command shall, moreover, have some powerful resources in their control. Isaiah, Chapter 13, verse 3 gives us insight as to who this mighty group of individuals are. Let us read:

"I יהודה] have commanded My sanctified ones, I have also called My mighty ones for Mine anger, even them that rejoice in My highness."

At this point we can read our foundation research Scripture with new found knowledge and understanding. So, let us read Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1 in part:

"[In addition to the occurrences in Revelation, Chapter 14, I, John, a servant of ההוה, came to find out information that was not previously known before because it was being hidden. But an angel of ההוה has told me, in a written source, about a second portentous incident or phenomenon that is evidence of future evil. This occurred while I was at the height of achievement. What I saw was an exciting wonder which contains vocal utterances that are free from error and logically valid] and marvelous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God."

Moving forward in our study of the word *great*, we will at this time analyze the definitions of the Hebrew word *gahdahl*, the primary root of the word *gahdol*, found in the *Strong's Expanded Concordance* under the reference number 1431. This will be done so that we have no question about the magnitude of the sign the Prophet John visualized or categorized as *great* in our foundation Scripture. *Gahdahl* means, "to become strong, significant, or valuable."

Trusting the truthfulness of the *Microsoft Encarta Reference Library* 2004, copyright 1993-2003, Computer Edition, for something to become

strong it has to be, "supported by good evidence and likely to be correct."

The Synonym Finder, by J.I. Rodale, copyright 1978, states that correct is "accurate." It is obvious for us to comprehend that this great sign provided to John by the angel of יהוה was supported by good evidence. Secondly, the information enclosed within this special sign was also likely to be correct and accurate when it was revealed.

The word **strong** also means that a thing is, "believed or expressed without any doubt." This is substantiated through the *Cambridge Dictionary* of *American English*, copyright 2000, Computer Software. Thus, we can infer from our definition that this great sign was believed and expressed to John by the angel of הוה without any doubt whatsoever from him. No, "Well, I 'think' that's what 'הוה said that means, but I'm not quite sure." Praise

The successive word that needs to be explained from our definition of the Hebrew word **gahdahl** (from the word **great**) is the word **significant**. Plainly documented in the *American Heritage Talking Dictionary*, copyright 1997, Computer Software, **significant** means, "having a major effect."

Giving credence to what we have just stated, we can formulate the understanding that this sign spoken of in Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1 is so *great* that it will have a major effect on the outcome of something.

What is the major effect that will occur as a consequence of this sign?

It will be, unequivocally, the pouring out of the wrath of הוה through His seven last vials of judgment. This unprecedented wrath and fury that our Almighty God, הוה, will let loose--by way of His Seven Last Plagues--shall come down ferociously upon the United States of America and the world.

In Random House Webster's Unabridged Dictionary, copyright 1999, Software Edition, significant is described as, "of consequence." While something of consequence is, "a result of an action or situation, especially a bad result," according to the Cambridge Dictionary of American English, copyright 2000, Computer Software. Now we can take into account and resolve that this sign of consequence will bring about a bad result from an action or situation.

Something **bad** as taken from the *American Heritage Talking*Dictionary, copyright 1997, Computer Software, is something "disagreeable,

unpleasant, or disturbing." So, the consequences of this specific action or situation that shall take place will result in an especially disagreeable, unpleasant, and disturbing outcome.

The Seven Last Plagues are the consequence that will bring about the action and situation that shall be especially disagreeable, unpleasant, and disturbing to people all over the earth no matter what social class they are in or color what they are. This time of trouble, biblically hailed as The Great Tribulation, shall be unlike any other natural disaster, state of emergency, or global catastrophe this world has ever known. Let us read Matthew, Chapter 24, verse 21 for added proof of this:

"For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be."

Praise יהוה! Isn't it good to know the Man that we will be with is the only
One who can save us during these troublous times? Praise יהוה בן יהוה (הוה בן יהוה בן יהוה).

Our working definition of the Hebrew word for *great*, pronounced **gahdahl**, is strong, significant, and valuable. So far, we have uncovered the

meanings of the words *strong* and *significant*, so the word **valuable** is last in line. From *The New Oxford American Dictionary*, copyright 2001, Computer Edition, **valuable** means "extremely useful or important." With this clear interpretation of the word valuable in correlation with the word *great*, it is very much apparent that the sign viewed by the Prophet John was extremely useful and important to understand clearly the outcome of events to take place in the future.

Useful is certified in the *Microsoft Encarta Reference Library 2004*, copyright 1993-2003, Computer Edition, as "serving some purpose." Important is verified in the *American Heritage Talking Dictionary*, copyright 1997, Computer Software, as "strongly affecting the course of events or the nature of things."

This great sign will not only serve the particular purpose of bringing about the Seven Last Plagues, but will over and above strongly affect the course of future world events and the nature of things in what this so-called modern society calls a normal world.

Praise יהוה! Let us read our foundation research Scripture again with all that we have gathered thus far to achieve our receiving of wisdom and knowledge. Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1, please read:

"[In addition to the occurrences in Revelation, Chapter 14, I, John, a servant of ההוה, came to find out information that was not previously known before because it was being hidden. But an angel of ההוה has told me, in a written source, about a second portentous incident or phenomenon that is evidence of future evil. This occurred while I was at the height of achievement. What I saw was an exciting wonder which contains vocal utterances that are free from error and logically valid which foretold of the course of future events and the nature of things that shall have a major effect on the United States and the world] and [it was] marvelous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God ההוה היהודה in them is filled up the wrath of God."

Seeing as though we now possess the necessary understanding of the word *great* and its relation to the Scripture, Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1 in its true form, at this time we can move forward in our course of study to define and scrutinize the word *marvelous*. The word marvelous is used as the second descriptive word to identify the sign the holy prophet John saw from the angel of הוה in our foundation research Scripture.

Marvelous as dictated in *The New Strong's Expanded Exhaustive Concordance of the Bible, Red-Letter Edition*, copyright 2001, on page 226, under the reference number 6381 of the Hebrew dictionary, is spelled 875 (Pey, Lamed, Aleph), pronounced *pah-lah*. **Pahlah** means "to accomplish and perform."

The word **accomplish** is recorded from *Microsoft Encarta Reference Library 2004*, copyright 1993-2003, Computer Edition, as "to arrive at the end of a period of time." Some synonyms of **accomplish** as found in *The Synonym Finder, by J.I. Rodale*, copyright 1978, are finish, put an end to, and terminate.

Keeping in the way of our definition and synonyms of the word accomplish, we can ascertain that this *marvelous* sign John--a holy man of "הוה"--saw is an alert that signals the arrival at the end of a certain period of time. This sign shall also serve as a symbol to the world today that "הוה" shall indeed finish, put an end to, and terminate the rulership of the Devil who has been ruling during this certain period of time. Let us read Revelation, Chapter 12, verse 12:

"Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the *devil* is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a *short time*."

We know that הוה gave Lucifer 6,000 years to rule and that his 6,000-year timespan is up! Praise יהוה!

Let us now persist and expound on the word **perform**, which is also taken from the Hebrew word **palah**, translated in English as *marvelous*. The *Random House Webster's Unabridged Dictionary*, copyright 1999, Software Edition, validates the word **perform** as, "to fulfill a command or promise." **Fulfill**, from the same source means, "to carry out as a prophecy." Furthermore, the *Microsoft Encarta Reference Library 2004*, copyright 1993-2003, Computer Edition, verifies the word **perform** as, "to do what is stated."

These definitions confirm that "הוה" shall use this sign in Revelation,

Chapter 15, verse 1 to fulfill His command and promise to do what is stated
and to carry out His prophecy according to the Scriptures. That great and
marvelous sign He showed His prophet John in Revelation 15:1 shall be the

realization of *The Seven Last Plagues* that shall be a culmination of all the plagues, signs, and wonders that our God, הוה, shall call forth from His heavenly arsenal of pestilences to destroy the unrighteous and abominable from off His planet earth in the Last Days. Let us read Luke, Chapter 21, verse 11:

"And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; and fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven."

Alright, family, Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1 will be read once again to complete our dictionary account of the phrase "great and marvelous." Please read:

"[In addition to the occurrences in Revelation, Chapter 14, I, John, a servant of ההוה, came to find out information that was not previously known before because it was being hidden. But an angel of ההוה has told me, in a written source, about a second portentous incident or phenomenon that is evidence of future evil. This occurred while I was at the height of achievement. What I saw was an exciting wonder which contains vocal utterances that are free from error and logically valid which foretold of the course of future events and the nature of things that shall have a major effect on the United States and the world. This exciting wonder will signal the arrival at the end of a period of time in which ההוה shall carry out His prophecy], [with] seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God."

Praise ''!

We have now consummated our analysis of the first half of our foundation research Scripture, which reads in part, "And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous ..." Therefore, we can continue our voyage into the wonderful world of הוה by decoding the next portion of our Scripture, Revelation 15:1, which is the phrase "... seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God, הוה "."

We will begin by delving wholeheartedly into the meaning of the number word **seven**, as it is really meant to be interpreted and perceived from our foundation research Scripture.

Soundly, stated in *The New Strong's Expanded Exhaustive Concordance of the Bible*, *Red-Letter Edition*, copyright 2001, under the reference number 7650 of the Hebrew dictionary, **seven** is spelled NDV (Shin, Bet, Aleph), pronounced *shah-bah*. **Shahbah** means "to be complete." **Complete** is described in *The New Oxford American Dictionary*, copyright 2001, as to "make (something) whole or perfect." **Whole** from the *Merriam Webster's 11th Collegiate Dictionary*, copyright 2003, Computer

Software, means "directed to one end"; and to make something **perfect** is to make it "pure and total."

We can now state irrefutably, as a result of what we have just read, that these Last Plagues, which will number up to seven, shall make whole and perfect the destruction of the world as we know it to be today. 'הוה has already directed these plagues to this one end, which is the pure and total annihilation of the carnal mind-set so that His Holy City, New Jerusalem, may come down from heaven to its pre-ordained place on earth. Let us all read Revelation, Chapter 21, verse 2:

"And I John saw the holy city, [N]ew Jerusalem, coming down from God, ההוה, out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband."

Praise יהוה '! The English word seven is also found in *The Strong's Exhaustive Concordance* under the reference number 7651 of the Hebrew dictionary, spelled שבעה or משבעה (Shin, Bet, Ayin or Shin, Bet, Ayin Hey), pronounced *sheh-bah*. **Shehbah** is defined as a "primary cardinal number; *seven* (as the sacred *full* one)."

A cardinal number is "any of the numbers that express amount"; and seven is stated as "a set of this many things," according to the definitions from the *Random House Webster's Unabridged Dictionary*, copyright 1999, Software Edition.

As a result of expounding upon the preceding words, we can maintain what is written the Scripture, Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1 to confirm that the Last Plagues will only amount to the number **seven**. The Last Plagues are in fact a set of seven things--no more and no less.

Seven was also defined from our Strong's Exhaustive Concordance definition, "as the sacred full one (number)." Something that is sacred is "dedicated or devoted exclusively to a single use or purpose." Likewise, full means "complete in every particular." These definitions are substantiated in the American Heritage Talking Dictionary, copyright 1997, Computer Software.

We can all agree that these **Last Plagues**, numbering only to the amount of seven, are extremely essential to the outcome of future events; primarily because they are dedicated and devoted exclusively to a single use

and purpose. What is this single use and purpose for these plagues? The answer is, of course, the pouring out of the seven last vials of judgment which hold these seven plagues. Furthermore, these astounding plagues are complete in every particular. This means that הוה has not left absolutely anything out of His plan of utter devastation by way of His Seven Last Plagues. Praise

We are still on our journey of enlightenment to reveal the true nature of our foundation research Scripture Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1. We are also continuing our decoding of words in this seminar today and will now take time to define the word angel. Revelation 15:1 firmly dictates that "און" will carry out and accomplish His written prophecy and command through "... seven angels having the seven last plagues ..."

Authenticated in *The New Strong's Expanded Exhaustive*Concordance of the Bible, Red-Letter Edition, copyright 2001, reference

number 4397, the Hebrew word for angel is spelled אלק"ל (Mem, Lamed,

Aleph, Chaf-Sofet), pronounced mahl-ahk. Mahlahk means "to dispatch as a deputy."

On the record in *Microsoft Encarta Reference Library* 2004, copyright 1993-2003, Computer Edition, to **dispatch** means, "to instruct somebody to go somewhere to carry out a task." A task is also a **charge**. It has just been proven that הוה, the God of Heaven, will instruct some persons--called angels--to go and carry out His charge in the Last Days.

These angels will be instructed to go and carry out this charge from הוה" as deputies. So what is the significance of these angels of הוה" being referred to as deputies? Well, Microsoft Encarta Reference Library 2004, copyright 1993-2003, Computer Edition, affirms that a deputy is "somebody who has been authorized or appointed to act on behalf of somebody else with full authority." Here we see that הוה" will authorize these appointed persons or beings to act on His behalf with His full authority to carry out the charge of fulfilling His Seven Last Plagues.

An **angel**, still from the same source, is "a divine being who acts as a messenger of God [יהוה"]." A **messenger** is also identified as a "gobetween." These divine beings that will number only to the amount of **seven** in all shall act as go-betweens for our God, יהוה, to achieve the task and

charge that He has already set forth for them in the Scripture. Let us turn to and read Matthew, Chapter 13, verse 41:

41 "The Son of Man shall send forth His *angels*, and they shall gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity."

Moving right along to wholly understand the segment of our study Scripture which reads, "... seven angels having the seven last plagues ...," we must define the next words in sequence which are having and the.

Having comes from the word have which is defined in The New Oxford American Dictionary, copyright 2001, Computer Edition, as "to possess or be provided with something." It also confirms that the is, "used to refer to a thing that is unique."

Concurring with what the aforementioned dictionary unmistakably printed, we can verify that these seven divine beings of הוה that shall act as go-betweens for Him during The Great Tribulation possess things that are unique, and which will be were provided to them by הוה. These unique things that they possess are biblically named and known as the *Seven Last Plagues* in Revelation 15:1.

We can now read our foundation research Scripture yet again today with our new found understanding that we have received from our diligent inquiry into the word of יהוה?! Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1, please read:

"[In addition to the occurrences in Revelation, Chapter 14, I, John, a servant of ההד", came to find out information that was not previously known before because it was being hidden. But an angel of has told me, in a written source, about a second portentous incident or phenomenon that is evidence of future evil. This occurred while I was at the height of achievement. What I saw was an exciting wonder which contains vocal utterances that are free from error and logically valid which foretold of the course of future events and the nature of things that shall have a major effect on the United States and the world. This exciting wonder will signal the arrival at the end of a period of time in which is shall carry out His prophecy with a perfect number of divine beings appointed by Him to act on His behalf with His full authority to carry out His charge of fulfilling His] seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God in."

Praise יהוה!

We are continuing our decoding of the phrase "... seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God, "הו"." It was made known previously that the number seven is a complete number dedicated exclusively to a single purpose. Therefore, it is not just

the number amount in which הוה has chosen for His angels, but it is also the number of His Last Plagues.

With that being said, we can go on and look up the word last from the phrase "... seven angels having the seven last plagues ..." Last from The New Oxford American Dictionary, copyright 2001, Computer Edition, is defined as, "coming after all others in time or order; final." This means that these seven plagues will come after all of the other plagues in time and order in the Bible. They will be the final declaration and expression of the wrath of הוה? that the world shall witness.

Last, from another standpoint, in conformity with the *American Heritage Talking Dictionary*, copyright 1997, Computer Software, means, "highest in extent or degree; utmost." Conclusively, we can gather that these seven plagues decreed in Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1, will not only come after all other plagues in time, but these seven plagues shall also be the highest in extent or degree. They shall be the utmost of plagues; this is to say, they shall be like no other plagues, disasters, or catastrophes ever known to man.

It is now time for our verbalization of the word plague. Plagues is the plural form of the word plague, which is predicated in Random House Webster's Unabridged Dictionary, copyright 1999, Software Edition, as "any widespread affliction, calamity, or evil, especially one regarded as a direct punishment by God [יהוה], such as a plague of war and desolation." It is, without a doubt, evident that the seven last and final plagues shall cause widespread affliction, calamity, and evil that will be a direct punishment by God, יהוה, on the inhabitants of the land for not keeping His laws.

These afflictions, calamities, and evils that shall come upon the masses after all others in time shall be plagues of war and desolation, as written in the Scripture. Moreover, the masses of the people shall be caught unawares when these evil plagues arise. Let us read Isaiah, Chapter 47, verse 11:

"Therefore shall evil come upon thee; thou shalt not know from whence it riseth: and mischief shall fall upon thee; thou shalt not be able to put it off: and *desolation* shall come upon thee suddenly, which thou shalt not know."

Let us also read Jeremiah, Chapter 51, verse 29:

"And the land shall tremble and sorrow: for every purpose of the LORD, יהוה, shall be performed against Babylon, to make the land of Babylon a desolation without an inhabitant."

Praise יהוה! Let us now finish decoding the remaining part of our Scripture, which is "... for in them is filled up the wrath of God, הוה?". We will do this by defining the words them, filled, and wrath. Authorized by Microsoft Encarta Reference Library 2004, copyright 1993-2003, Computer Edition, the word them is "used to refer to a group of things." The group of things being referred to in this Scripture is the Seven Last Plagues. Hence, the phrase "for in them is filled up the wrath of God, הוה," could say, "for in the seven last plagues is filled up the wrath of God, הוה,"."

The New Oxford American Dictionary, copyright 2001, Computer Edition, defines fill, the root word of filled, as, "to become full of." Full from the Bartlett's Roget's Thesaurus, copyright 1996, on page 671, reference #761.5, means "maximum." Thus, the seven last plagues are become full to maximum capacity with the wrath of God, "הוה.".

What is the wrath of God, ההה, like? Well, let us find out. Wrath in The New Strong's Expanded Exhaustive Concordance of the Bible, Red-Letter Edition, copyright 2001, in the Greek dictionary, reference number 2375, is pronounced thoo-mos. Thumos is fierceness and indignation. So these seven last plagues of הוה are full to the maximum with His fierceness and indignation that shall be poured out upon the entire world. Let us read Psalm, Chapter 69, verse 24:

"Pour out Thine indignation upon them, and let Thy wrathful anger take hold of them."

The American Heritage Talking Dictionary, copyright 1997, Computer Software, defines wrath as, "punishment or vengeance as a manifestation of anger; divine retribution for sin." Vengeance is equivalent to curse. While retribution according to The New Oxford American Dictionary, copyright 2001, is "punishment that is considered to be morally right and fully deserved."

I'm sure that we are all in accord with the facts confirming that the wrath of יהוה is His punishment and curse of men as a manifestation of His

anger toward them. And, not only that, but the wrath of יהוה is also His divine punishment that is morally right and "fully" deserved by those who receive it.

So to know that *The Seven Last Plagues*, which shall torment the people of the earth in the Last Days, are full to the max with all this fierceness and righteous indignation should surely make us want to straighten up and fly right to the Son, הוה בן יהוה להוה בן יהוה להוה בן יהוה לחות that the moral people of the earth shall be saved from the great vengeance and retribution of His Father, יהוה להוה בן יהוה, shall take vengeance on His adversaries and reserve wrath for His enemies. Let us read Nahum, Chapter 1, verse 2:

"הוה is jealous, and the LORD, יהוה, revengeth; the LORD, יהוה, revengeth and is furious; the LORD, יהוה, will take *vengeance* on His adversaries, and He reserveth *wrath* for His enemies."

Let us also read Revelation, Chapter 6, verses 15 through 17:

15 "And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains:

16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of Him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

17 For the great day of His wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?"

Praise יהוה!

We have reached the point in our discussion where we will read our foundation research Scripture one last time with all that we have uncovered and searched. Revelation, Chapter 15, verse 1, please read:

"In addition to the occurrences in Revelation, Chapter 14, I, John, a servant of ההד", came to find out information that was not previously known before because it was being hidden. But an angel of has told me, in a written source, about a second portentous incident or phenomenon that is evidence of future evil. This occurred while I was at the height of achievement. What I saw was an exciting wonder which contains vocal utterances that are free from error and logically valid which foretold of the course of future events and the nature of things that shall have a major effect on the United States and the world. This exciting wonder will signal the arrival at the end of a period of time in which ההרה shall carry out His prophecy with a perfect number of divine beings appointed by Him to act on His behalf with His full authority to carry out His charge of fulfilling His seven final afflictions, for in these seven final afflictions is full to the maximum the indignation, vengeance, and divine retribution of God, ההרה "הרה"."

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Praise יהוה! Praise יהוה! I pray that you all are now imbued with at

least some information that may be of use as we gear up for the final battle

between the righteous and wicked people of the earth. This battle will, of a

certainty, be fought within our hearts and minds. So let us prepare ourselves

with the whole shield and armor of our God, הוה.
