

The time again for the solemn commemoration of *Passover and Feast of Unleavened Bread* is approaching quickly. So why do we reverently recognize this occasion, and how are we to deferentially celebrate it? The Scriptures instruct that this holy event is to be observed in the time appointed by an ordinance forever, in the place where God, הוה', chooses to place His name according to all that He commanded Moses, including the eating of unleavened bread for seven days; exalting and praising the Lord, הוה', who so mercifully delivered us from Egypt and her plagues by night (Exodus 12:43; Numbers 9:2, 5; 28:16-17; Deuteronomy 16:1-2).

Night is more than just that period between sunset and sunrise; it symbolizes a condition or time of obscurity, ignorance, sinfulness, misfortune, etc. Therefore, ההה brought us out of Egypt during a time when Egypt was experiencing doom and gloom, when its citizens were acting sinfully and operating without knowledge, when the people were unaware of or deliberately ignoring the truth, and when the conditions of the country were disastrous, troublesome, adverse, divisive, and catastrophic.

It's reminiscent of conditions in the world today; especially in America, isn't it? The political climate alone has Americans in a constant state of vexation: one group believes it is insignificant to those in power, even as yet another faction believes the government is unaware of its concerns. And at the same time control over limited financial resources, religious dogma and ritual practices, plus racial disparities deeply divide the populous of the nation once called the "great melting pot" of cultures.

While this chaos continues, the people still struggle daily to live in a society that advocates working to spend and consume what is earned, even beyond one's means. But why labor for such perishable commodities and trappings, instead of for those things that endure unto everlasting life? For this is but one of the plagues, or signs of affliction, foretold to manifest at the end time, which the Son of Man, הוה בן יהוה של, has shown the world that it might believe. And as we witness His word come to pass, **we See** יהוה בן יהוה Son **Crowned with Glory and Honor** (Hebrews 2:9).

Thus, do not be among those who have seen His works and yet still do not believe, but instead, accept the fact that יהוה has in place a plan for the deliverance of the righteous from this period of night.

In the past He called forth Moses to lead us out of Egypt, but this time He has sent His Beloved Son, יהוה בן יהוה בן יהוה to be our guiding Light; therefore, do not despair, but faithfully **Stand Still and See The Salvation of** יהוה בן יהוה (Exodus 14:13).

And the place from which to witness and learn of His authoritative and miraculous liberating powers is at our *Thirty-Ninth Annual Passover and Feast of Unleavened Bread,* to be held April 1 through April 8, 2019, at the **Embassy Suites Hotel and Convention Center, San Marcos, Texas.** Why wait? # FEAST PERFORMANCE GUIDELINES

In keeping with the standards that nation, The Feast Committee has instituted the following performance guidelines to ensure that we continue to show respect and reverence toward His moral teachings. Therefore, to be in accord with Titus 2:1-8, 10, all—adults as well as children—wishing to perform during our nightly program must adhere to the performance criteria listed below:

A. Our Passover and Feast of **Unleavened Bread 6022** theme is: "Stand Still and יהוה See The Salvation of בו (Exodus 14:13) "יהוה and our overall theme for the year is: "We See בן יהוה הוה Crowned With Glorv and Honor" (Hebrews 2:9). All performances must reflect research done on either the themes or Passover and Feast of Unleavened Bread. The use of on-line dictionaries and thesauruses are prohibited as creditable sources of reference.

All performers must wear either "full" culture or "full" business attire. All diadems worn must have the standard "V" wrap. No sheer or revealing fabrics, as well as no formfitting, low-cut, or form-showing garments should be worn. Sisters must wear long, anklelength, free-flowing outer cultural garments (tops, skirts, or dresses). Brothers must wear loose-fitting, ankle-length cultural pants. Arms must be covered, and legs must be covered with appropriate leg stockings. No one with unclean garments, shoes, or diadems, and wearing false fingernails and makeup lip gloss, lip stick, mascara, eye shadow, and the like—will be permitted to perform.

**B.** All performers must submit a video format for all proposed performances. Video formats must be qualitative, audible, and accompanied by the type-written words/lyrics of the song, recitation, poem, play, and music voiceovers. Voiceovers should be readings or recitations that are applicable to the



themes, the feasts, KJV Bible stories, or parables. Your performance should not exceed seven (7) minutes. No rough drafts will be accepted. All submissions must be in their "final" stage.

- **C. Recitations:** All recitations, plays, poems, welcomes, exordiums, including HIA, must adhere to paragraphs A and B above.
- D. Music/Songs: All singers and musicians must adhere to paragraphs A and B above. In addition, no singing or playing of secular (worldly) songs to יהוה סי יהוה בן יהוה tuals created before 1920, the use of secular samples,

melodies, or any portion of worldly music as original compositions is prohibited. Any one found violating this guideline shall be suspended from performing. Music choices are: הוה music and "original" songs, instrumentals, and/or jazz compositions. All instrumental and jazz compositions must be accompanied by Scriptural or poetic voiceovers. (Persons doing the voiceovers, if not appearing on the stage, do not have to appear on your video submission.)

E. Dances: All dancers must adhere to paragraphs A and B above. In addition, dances must have a moral mes-All instrumental dance sage. music must be accompanied by voiceovers as stated in paragraph D. Dances must exemplify cultural connotations that represent the principles of chastity as taught by יהוה בן יהוה. Body movements should not be suggestive or sexually explicit, i.e., hip thrusts, hip rolls, gyrations, or clutching of the breast or crotch area.

All performances must be sent to The Feast Committee by February 15, 2019. Any performance received without registration is denied. The Feast Committee will respond to all unacceptable performances by March 23, 2019. Please mail your performance(s) to The Feast Committee, P.O. Box 1138, Seguin, TX 78156.

All welcomes and exordiums must be auditioned live. Therefore, if you are performing either of these, please visit the registration desk upon your arrival to arrange for an audition before you are scheduled to appear on our nightly program.
